The village people have been hard hit with a serious decline in pulpo fishing when they make most of their money and the albaniles (stone masons) have had over 300 building works cancelled this past week because owners have not done the environmental impact study required by law. So everyone is looking for help.

I am sorry to say the cost of providing the despensas has increased I will be letting you know about the new cost to feed a family for the upcoming year.
